

Embroidery Club-Dresden Applique Wall Quilt
Jan 2017

Things to Bring:

- Embroidery machine, embroidery presser foot, embroidery bobbin case
- Embroidery needles (#90)
- OESD Design #12652 Dresden Appliques
- Large oval hoop or equivalent.
- Heavyweight tear away stabilizer
- Fabric- (You will note that I have upped the yardages based on my experience making the sample.)
 - Backgrounds: light – 2 ½ yds, dark – 2yds
 - Applique fabrics: light - ¾ yd, light medium - ¾ yd, medium – ½ yd, dark medium - ¾ yd, dark - ¾ yd
 - Other fabric requirements are in the instructions
- Scissors
- Embroidery snips
- Embroidery thread-The colors will be determined by your applique fabrics.
- Bobbin thread and an extra empty bobbin

Pre-class Preparation:

- Transfer the designs to your machine or on a USB or on your laptop for direct connection to your machine.
- Print PDF of the instruction and thread chart.
- Cut the applique fabrics (2 ½" X 4 ½" rectangles instead of wedges).
- Cut the background fabrics according to the pattern. What I did was cut 14" strips and then split each into 4 pieces.
