

Something Fishy Quilt

Dive into your scraps and swim away with this adorable wall-hanging / child's quilt. Bet you didn't know a scrappy school of fish is hiding in your novelty scraps! Here's what to bring to the class:

- Sewing machine, thread, pins, sewing supplies
- Rotary mat, cutter, straight ruler (7x14)" and other tools that you are comfortable with.
- Something Fishy pattern (Included in class fee)
- **2 yards** watery blue fabric for background and binding.
- Your ScrapTherapy bins with 3 1/2" and 5" scraps
- One package 1 1/2" Star Singles
- Olfa Rotating Cutting Mat very helpful

If you want to make a larger quilt plan fabric accordingly.

Advance preparation: Before the first session, cut **65** - 5" squares from your watery background fabric. From your scrap bins, you will use **59** each of 3 1/2" and 5" scrap squares to make the fish blocks. ***HOWEVER, do not select scraps for the fish blocks before class.*** Instead, bring an ample collection of varied 3 1/2" and 5" squares to the session.
